How do I apply the Cell Guard Sliver Plus?

For best adhesion, make sure the phone's surface is clean. Apply the guard to a dry, flat surface.

What if I have a case on my phone?

If you have a case on your phone, apply the Cell Guard directly to the case. DO NOT cover the Cell Guard Sliver Plus with a case.

Can I move my Cell Guard Sliver Plus from one cell phone to another?

GIA does NOT recommend moving a Cell Guard from one phone to another - unless the new phone is the exact same make and model of the original phone. Different phones emit and receive different frequency ranges, therefore the Cell Guard Sliver Plus should not be transferred.

What is the lifespan of my Cell Guard Sliver?

The patented polymer inside the Cell Guard Sliver Plus has a lifespan of 2 years and the Cell Guard Sliver has a lifespan of 1 year - each should be replaced with a new Cell Guard accordingly.

Will the Cell Guard affect the signal strength of my phone?

The Cell Guard has been designed to neutralize the effects of your exposure to EMR, while leaving the signal strength and clarity of your phone unaffected.

Is the Cell Guard Sliver water and heat resistant?

Generally speaking, Cell Guards are water and heat resistant. However, it's safe to say that if your Cell Guard is actually submerged in water or catches fire, you'll need to replace it.

What's the difference between the Cell Guard Sliver and the GIA Universal Guard?

There are a few key differences between the two. The amount of patented polymer used in the Universal Guard is different than in the Cell Guard, as it is designed to be used on larger electronic devices. Their individual shapes and packaging are different as well.

If I use a hands-free headset, do I still need to put a Cell Guard Sliver on my phone?

Yes, we still recommend you use the Cell Guard Sliver or Sliver Plus on your cell phone. The best way to address EMR emitted from your cell phone while experiencing hands-free convenience is to use the Cell Guard Sliver and the Mini Slivers.
